What's Happening In MacMad

In the last MacBits I mentioned that MacMad is getting better attention from vendors. Many benefits come from this attention, not the least of which is free stuff. Our upcoming meetings should see the return of software giveaways and other goodies. In addition, most of these vendors provide nice discounts to User Group Members purchasing the software.

These vendors also offer a lot of software for evaluation. Usually, this is a download of the software along with an evaluation license. The evaluation license is exactly the same as a purchased license except that you are not allowed to sell the software.

We really need a lot of participation to fully take

advantage of these evaluations, and they can lead to some very interesting discussions. For example, we now have evaluation copies of Now Up to Date and Contact and of Chronos Personal Organizer. These are competitors to Palm Desktop and Entourage. The retail versions are not free, but possibly a case of getting what you pay for.

I would like to propose a fun challenge. In order to easily review and compare this software, I would like volunteers to represent each program, including Palm and Entourage. Hopefully, we have someone who is using each of the latter. We need someone to take the Now product and another person to take Personal Organizer. After a couple of months of using

the program, we will schedule a program at which each can tell us the pros and cons of the programs.

There are several similar competing sets of applications in the Mac world, including the page composition programs, graphics and the like. This comparison format can give us the ability to have an overview of the programs without anyone having to prepare a full presentation. The write-up of the comparisons should also be popular. As I have said before, don't worry about the write up. If you don't consider yourself a writer, we can give you help.

Our program options are also improving. We have leads on several Mac users

About Last Meeting

Jim Staal opened the meeting at 7:05pm while I was finishing setting up the display computer for the evening, a Apple PowerBook 17" unit.

Jim dove right into his presentation on using several shareware applications that he thinks to be of use. They are: NoteTaker 2003 From:

<http://www.versiontracker.com> comes the following description: NoteTaker 2003 is powerful new OS X software for organizing your information lifestyle, your digital workstyle.

At its most basic level, NoteTaker is a personal note and idea organizer. With NoteTaker, you can make a list, organize an outline or jot down an idea. It's that basic. But with everyday work and lifestyle demands, our information needs are far more complex and diverse. And NoteTaker reflects this reality so that users can add and change the content and use of their information as needed.

NoteTaker's user inter-

face metaphor uses a visually rich "spiral" notebook pages with section tabs. Some users will simply have one tab and a long list of outlines while others will organize entire project and research journals with many sections and many pages within those tab sections. And it makes no difference how you decide to organize and use NoteTaker, it's flexible yet easy to understand. It's like having electronic paper on your OS X desktop.

In short, NoteTaker applications are unlimited. From managing the daily to do list information to sharing a project team binder across the Internet, NoteTaker becomes the software of our everyday lifestyle. Use it to communicate ideas. Organize personal information. Keep a project journal. Think on paper. NoteTaker is software you'll want to use every single day.

Next was Chronos Organizer. From <http://www.macupdate.com> comes the following description. Personal Organizer (Previously Consultant) is a full-featured information manager. It has built-in caller ID functionality, can translate sentences that you

write for appointments to automatically schedule an event, print mailing labels, and more.

Lastly Jim showed URL Manager Pro. From <http://www.macupdate.com> is this description. URL Manager is a full-featured, stand alone Macintosh application that allows users to create a single, highly flexible repository for maintaining URLs. In particular, URL Manager offers tight integration with Netscape Navigator and Microsoft Internet Explorer Web browsers for effortless management of Web Page bookmarks. This release of URL Manager Pro has a feature that lets you "Reload" the Bookmarks menu in Netscape Navigator with the bookmarks of a URL Manager document. You can now "Reload" the Bookmarks menu conveniently with the Cabinet and Select submenus from the URL Manager Pro shared icon menu. Safari, Apple's own web browser, currently has issues with this software, although this will probably change soon now that Safari 1.0 was released recently.

I showed off Default Folder and Imprint. These two applications are life savers for me what with all the folder levels I keep and the number of people and businesses that I have to stay in contact with.

FlipAlbum® 3 for Mac

Review by Cher Daley


FlipAlbum®3 for your Macintosh is an easy to use program that allows you to make a book of just about anything, providing you use the file formats listed below.

You can simply drop and drag any folder that contains all your files and FlipAlbum®3 will do all the work for you!

If you are familiar with photo editing tools such as illustrator or free hand you can create your own background or can buy ready made backgrounds. There is also a place on the Web to go to get other backgrounds.

You can control what you want to do by going into the preferences folder and thus finding multiple options such as auto flipping pages, backgrounds, covers, page colors, audio, etc.. This is a good place to start.. FlipAlbum®3 allows you several options in the page properties box. You can choose colors, textures or browse for art work in your own folders. You can choose to set

If you are familiar with an image editing tool (eg. Photoshop) you can design and incorporate your own book covers into your Flipbooks.



Main Toolbar

Toolbar Descriptions:

With the toolbar, you can quickly perform common actions that are found in the menu bar (icon descriptions are arranged in order, from Left to Right).

Open	opens an existing book
Folder	open a folder of pictures to compile them into a book.
Copy From	copy files from another folder
Copy (left/right page)	copy page to clipboard
Paste	paste an image from clipboard

AutoFlip	start/stop auto-flip

page positions and audio. By browsing through the audio section, you can link to your favorite MP3 files.

FlipAlbum®3 has drag and drop capabilities and you can also create a new FlipBook. You either open a folder containing your images/objects or start with a blank FlipBook and add the pages and images/objects one by one, or you can choose to open an existing FlipBook.

You can also rotate objects, and add more than one object to a page.

Batch Processing of Image Files

Batch Selection allows the user to do specific operations on multiple image files at the same time. The following batch functions are available in FlipAlbum:

Rotate: Rotates the selected

images.

Size Change: Resamples and changes the size of the selected images.

Copy Files To: Copies the selected files to a different directory.

Move Files To: Moves the selected files to a different directory.

Delete Files: Deletes the selected files.

You can also add music, multimedia clips and photos all on one page.

The program promises to become more interactive with features interchangeable with the PC version so you can exchange & record to CD's & DVD's this summer.






